GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE INSTITUTION

Since its creation in 1959, the EIVP is the only higher education institution delivering a diploma in Urban Engineering in France. Due to its superb location in Paris, at the heart of one of the liveliest districts, its appeal lies not only on the highly specialized education it offers, but also on the capital's international influence and diversity. It consequently takes advantage of this situation in order to establish a privileged network among higher education institutions, local administrations, companies and the industry.

PROGRAM PROPOSED & DESCRIPTION

Degree: Urban Engineer. The diploma is awarded together with the MSc degree. EUR-ACE label awarded to the Master's degree in Urban Engineering.

Duration of the studies: 3 years (180 ECTS)

Admission requirements : see « admission/registration procedures »

Education and professional goals: The engineers-to-be are trained to implement urban engineering techniques, take advantage of field experiences and practices, and communicate with local administrators and users; they will learn how to negotiate contracts, as well as to control and follow up development plans. Not only will they need to develop general skills and strategies, but also to assume responsibilities in a wide variety of careers.

The educational scheme is organised in 6 semesters and aims at allowing students to achieve a steady progress from general fundamental scientific knowledge to a proficiency in urban projects. They obtain the necessary theoretical knowledge and put that into practice by means of four training placements (one-third of the education period) and the realisation of their Final Projects.

Final examination: Final Project : « Travail de Fin d'Etudes » (TFE)

Examination and assessment regulations: Students' permanent work, both guided and personal, is assessed by professors throughout the academic year by means of projects, oral and written exams. Student's work assessment is reflected by the grades obtained at the end of each semester and of the academic year.

ADMISSION/REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

A. Admission via previously obtained degrees:

- **The admission in 1st year** is open to French and foreign students with a Bachelor's degree (or equivalent) in Mathematics, Physics, Mechanics, Civil Engineering, Informatics or Environmental Sciences.
- **The admission in 2nd year** is open to French and foreign students who have completed the first year of a Master's degree in Mathematics, Physics, Mechanics, Public Works, Industrial Production, Informatics, or Environmental Sciences.

Candidates must send a complete inscription dossier to the EIVP admission service before 15th May (dossier AST on the website):

- Application form (filled-in and signed). See website: http://www.eivp-paris.fr/index.php/Incoming_students/Etudiants_%C3%A9trangers?idpage=64&idmetacontenu=

- Curriculum vitae.
- Confidential letter from a referee (Dean or professor from the institution where the candidate studies).
- Higher education transcript of records.
- Degrees and diplomas obtained.
- The certificate of being enrolled in a Bachelor's degree (or equivalent) for 1st year's candidates, and in Master's degree (or equivalent) for 2nd year's candidates.
- Photocopy of passport or national identity card.
- Three stamped envelopes with the candidate's address.
- A photo.

Besides, the candidates whose mother tongue is not French must provide:

- Notarized translation of the passport or identity card.
- Proof of a good knowledge of French signed by the Cultural Attaché at the French Embassy or by a teacher at the « Alliance Française ». B1 level desirable.
- Official transcript in French of higher education studies.

Any incomplete dossier will be turned down.

Selection procedures

A first selection will be made after examining the dossiers; the list of selected candidates will be published on the website of the "Ecole" on the 30th of May at the latest. Admissible candidates, 24 maximum, are then required to pass an interview with a committee, consisting in:

- An interview on the scientific matters corresponding to the candidate's studies, as well as on his/her motivations.
- An interview in English on a general topic.

The list of successful candidates will be published on the website; they will also be notified individually.

The acceptance will become definitive when the candidates obtain their university diplomas and pay the corresponding fees.

B. Admissions for Exchange students (ERASMUS, BRAFITEC, bilateral agreements and Double Degrees)

The students participating in these programs must send the International Office the following documents:

- Printed copy of the application form
- Transcript of records
- CV in French
- Learning agreement signed by the sending institution
- Cover letter
- Photocopy of the passport or national identity card
- Two photos

Deadlines for candidates:

First semester: **1st June**

Second semester: **1st December**

C. Principal regulations

Learning agreement: a list of the courses to follow. It must be agreed upon by the student and the academic responsible authorities from both institutions before the student's departure. The learning agreement must be immediately updated in case of any change in the after the arrival in the receiving institution.

Transcript of records. It shows the student's results by specifying the courses followed, the credits obtained, and local as well as ECTS grades. The outgoing student's transcript must be emitted by the sending institution before the student's departure, whereas that of the incoming student has to be produced by the receiving institution before the end of the study period.
